CONGO AIR INCIDENT PROCEEDINGS

Sundance Resources Limited ("Sundance" or "the Company") (ASX: SDL) advises that it has been informed of court process filed in the Circuit Court for Cook County, Illinois on 7 June 2013.

The proceedings have been filed on behalf of the estates and survivors of John Jones, Don Lewis, Geoff Wedlock, John Carr-Gregg, James Cassley and Natasha Flason, who died on 19 June 2010 in the aircraft incident in the Republic of Congo.

These are fresh proceedings brought in a different jurisdiction from the now discontinued Federal Court proceedings previously brought in the USA.

The defendants named in the proceedings are:

- a) Garmin [sic] International Inc of Kansas USA
- b) Sundance Resources Limited
- c) Cam Iron SA (which is a 90% subsidiary of Sundance)
- d) Aero Services SARL
- e) Raymond Griesbaum, identified as a principal of Aero Services SARL

This process has not, at this time, been served on the Company or Cam Iron SA.

The proceedings claim unspecified damages on behalf of the claimants.

Should this matter proceed against Sundance or its subsidiaries, Sundance will vigorously defend any such actions.
